(1) Electrical

Discrepancy —for safety purposes, informed Mr. Rene S. Reyes the Director that they need to replace the electrical plate for the outlet.

(2) Signage

(3) Emergency

Emergency equipment's are installed at the facility (smoke detector, landline fire
