#### Staff Child Ratio

• The Provider met the Staff Child Ratio for their Infants and Toddlers. Staffs are present and are within the ratio capacity. *Nothing to report for any discrepancies or violations*.

#### (1) Electrical

- The facility complies on all the electrical safety aspects. However the following is recommended:
  - Electrical outlet at the outdoor area is unsecured. The outlet needs to be secured. This discrepancy must be addressed on the next inspection.

#### (2) Signage

- Most of the important signage's are visible and posted on proper designated areas. However, the following is recommended:
  - No exit sign posted at the isolation room. Exit signage in the nap room must be relocated to the actual exit door.
  - No evacuation plan posted. Was advised by the staff, it is being updated. However, evacuation plan must be posted at all times.

## (3) Emergency

- Emergency equipment's are installed at the facility (landline, alarm smoke detector) to include emergency plans posted. However, the following is recommended:
  - Fire extinguisher must be closely monitored monthly by the facility staff, and annual inspection required. The current fire extinguisher's inspection was on February 25, 2016 and February 29, 2016 respectively. An annual inspection is required.
  - No fire/smoke alarm in the isolation room. Installation is required. This discrepancy must be addressed immediately.



The first aid kit must be accessible and stationed at a noticeable location and must be replenished on a regular basis.

#### (4) Sanitary

• The facility is odor free, practicing sanitizing continuously prevention from any bacteria. Clean towels are provided and are replaced on a daily basis. Soap dispenser is readily available.

Nothing to report for any discrepancies or violations.

#### (5) Outdoor

- The facility's outdoor playground is safe for children enrolled at this Day Care Center to utilize. The playground is fully fenced. However, the following is recommended:
  - It is highly recommended that the front porch/lanai be cordoned off for the safety of the children and staff. The accessible entrance must be enclosed.

#### (6) Capacity

• The outdoor as well as the indoor facility for this Provider complies with the required square footage of space per child. *Nothing to report for any discrepancies or violations*.

#### (7) Health

• At the time of inspection, the teacher was unavailable and so there was no way to validate whether all the children's health insurance and their emergency contacts are readily available at the Providers facility file. *Nothing to report for any discrepancies or violations*.

## (8) Documents

• CCLP required documents remain pending. *Nothing to report for any discrepancies or violations*.

## (9) Other

 Drinking water dispenser is readily available at all times for staff and children. Nothing to report for any discrepancies or violations.
