The Provider met the Staff Child Ratio for their Infants and Toddlers, K-4&K-5. Staffs are present and are within the ratio capacity.

(1) Electrical

- The facility complies on all the electrical safety aspects. However, the following is recommended:
 - * The A/C outlet in the playroom must be covered with a plastic safety cap when not in use.
 - * The light bulb located in the infant toilet needs to be replaced. It failed to turn on when tested during the inspection.

(2) Signage

- Important signage's are visible and posted on proper designated areas. However, the following is recommended:
 - * There is no "Exit" sign in the K-3/K-4 playroom. An "Exit" sign must be placed on or above the door.

(3) Emergency

Emergency equipment's are installed at the facility (landline, alarm smoke detector) to include emergency plans posted. Nothing to report for any discrepancies or violations.

(4) Sanitary

• The facility is for the most part, odor free, practicing sanitizing continuously prevention from any bacteria. Clean towels are provided and are being replaced daily as well as soap dispenser is readily available. Nothing to report for any discrepancies or violations.

(5) Outdoor

- The facility outdoor playground is safe for children enrolled at this Day Care Center to utilized as well as fenced and gated. However, the following is recommended:
 - * The potted flower located at the outdoor playground must be removed due to its thorn production. The safety concern for the children is obvious.

(6) Capacity

• The outdoor as well as the indoor facility for this Provider complies with the required square footage of space per child. *Nothing to report for any discrepancies or violations.*

(7) Health

• The children's health insurance and their emergency contacts are all readily available at the Providers facility file. The staff practices washing their hands before and after eating as well as properly sanitized continuously counters/tables/chairs tops. Infant formulas as well as prescribed medications are properly stored. *Nothing to report for any discrepancies or violations*.

(8) Documents

• The facility has not turned in all CCLP required documents. The Provider's CCL expires on December 28, 2017. *Nothing to report for any discrepancies or violations.*

(9) Other

- Drinking water dispenser is readily available at all times for staff and children. The following is recommended:
 - * The ceiling paint in the main building has started peeling. Immediate corrective measures must be taken as this poses an obvious health and safety issues to the children and staffs.
