Staff Child Ratio:

1. Electrical:

• It was noted during the Announced Inspection that the outdoor play area had electrical outlets under a height of 7ft. It is required that electrical outlets under 7ft be covered by child-safe devices. *Discrepancy was corrected on-site*.

2. Signage:

• Signages were clearly visible and posted within designated areas. No discrepancies noted.

3. Emergency:

• Emergency kits/equipment were properly installed and readily available. Smoke detectors in each enclosed room were tested and functioning properly. *No discrepancies noted.*

4. Sanitation:

It was noted that a discarded diaper was found in a trash bin. Although not soiled, it was
recommended to place used diapers in a plastic bag for sanitary purposes prior to discarding
them.

5. Outdoor:

• Outdoor play area is fenced and maintained. No discrepancies noted.

6. Capacity:

• The facility capacity requirements are met per the issuance of a valid Occupancy Permit and observed during the CCLP Announced inspection. *No discrepancies noted.*

7. Health:

• Children's health information was available for review by authorized personnel when needed. Isolation room and procedures are in place. Upon notice of obvious symptoms by staff members, parents/guardians are notified immediately to pick child up. If parent/guardian is unable to do so, child is then transferred to isolation room for the remainder of the day.

8. Documents:

• All required licenses and applicable documentation observed were current, clearly visible, and placed in an organized fashion. *No discrepancies noted.*
