The Early Head Start Program operates in two sessions (AM/PM) with the same staff. But the enrolled children are divided in two groups of fours for each session. The center has met the staff/child ratio of 4 children to three teachers per session.

But I reminded Ms. Maranda Smith that CCLP required all childcare staff to accumulate 15 hours of training and/or technical assistance within a physical year, the submission of renewal application must be 60 calendar days prior to the expiration of the current Child Care license, and the center or staff required documents must be process for renewal 30 calendar days before the particular document expired. Ms. Maranda assured to submit annually the staff accrued training/technical assistant hours upon the submission of the renewal application.
