

## Child Care Providers Attend the Health and Safety Training on the Emergency Preparedness and Response Recovery Plan (EPRRP)

On March 23, 2024, fifteen (15) Child Care and Development Fund (CCDF) providers completed a two-and-a-half-hour training on the *Emergency Preparedness and Response Recovery Plan* (*EPRRP*). This training was facilitated by Evergreen Learning Training and Development Specialist, Grace M. Mallari.

This module meets a preservice requirement of the Child Care Development Block Grant Reauthorization Act of 2016. During the training, participants were able to identify the new federal requirements and health and safety standards for emergency preparedness and planning, define the different kinds of emergencies, articulate the importance of planning, identify natural disasters and human-caused events that should be addressed in emergency plans by CNMI childcare providers, and explore the six steps of emergency planning.
