Child Care Providers Attend the Health and Safety Training on the Administration of Medication, Consistent with Standards for Parental Consent

On April 27, 2024, nineteen (19) participants from SmartStart Nurtuting Center, Holy Angel, Pure Love I & II, and Team Koka—Tinian completed a two-hour training on the *Administration of Medication, Consistent with Standards for Parental Consent.* This training was facilitated by Evergreen Learning Training and Development Specialist, Grace M.
