Child Care Providers Attend the Health and Safety Training on the Prevention of and Response to Emergencies Due to Food and Allergic Reactions

On April 27, 2024, nineteen (19) participants from SmartStart Nurtuting Center, Holy Angel, Pure Love I & II, and Team Koka–Tinian completed a two-hour training on the *Prevention of and Response to Emergencies Due to Food and Allergic Reactions*. This training was facilitated by Evergreen Learning Training and Development Specialist, Grace M. Mallari.

During the session, the participants learned about food allergies, ways to prevent children’s exposure to them, and planned a response for food allergic reactions, including anaphylaxis.
